

Game theory in practice: How do you win “rock-paper-scissors”?

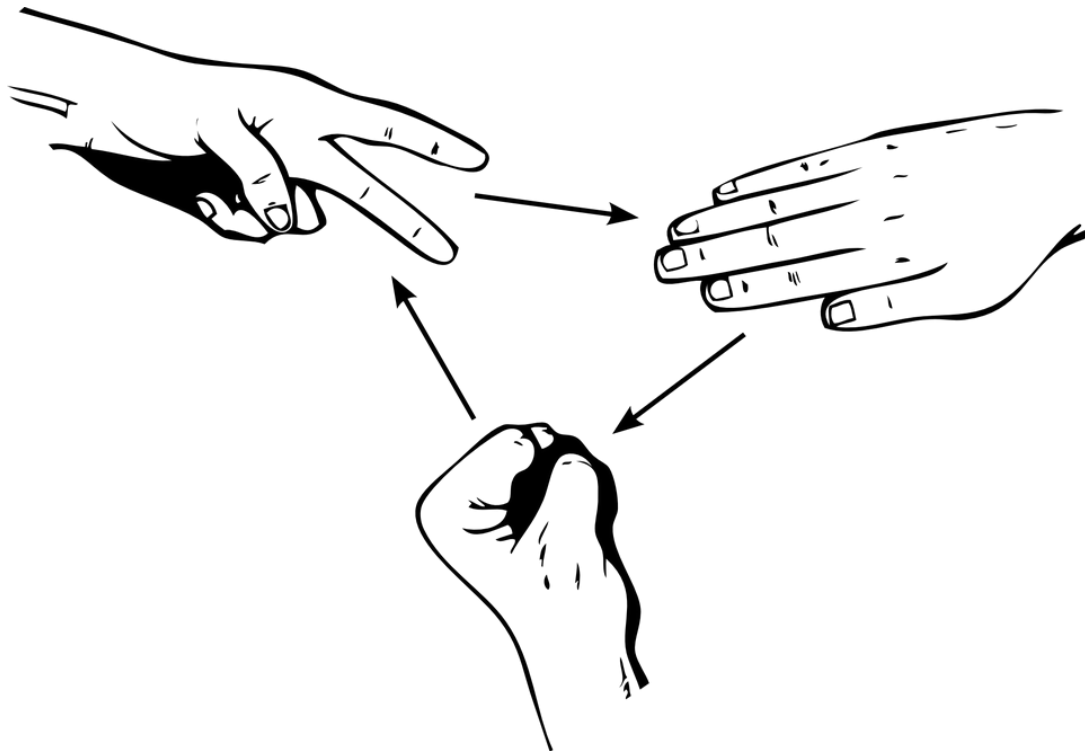

Scientists in China have researched the cult game “rock-paper-scissors” and found a strategy for winning:

Apparently, players do not make their decisions as randomly as you might think. In a field study with 360 players, researchers noticed two decisive behavioural patterns:

- Winners tend to repeat successful strategies.
- Conversely, losers do everything they can to change their tactics.
